Although this little store is about 10 minutes away from Historic Ellicott City, it's a don't-miss for shoppers looking for something to add a one-of-a-kind touch to their domicile. Sixteen local women are involved in this co-op, each with her own specific "shop" inside displaying her creative talents, from refinished antiques to handmade accent pieces. This shabby chic distressed white cabinet (\$275) was refinished by one of The Pink Cabbage's founders, Jody Perez. It's filled with milk glass pieces (\$2-\$22).
